- **Reverend....A mail order preacher**

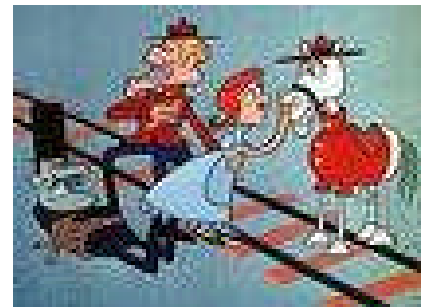

NEW ADVENT BANNER FOR FIRST PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH

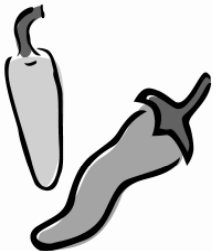
